Walk-in assistance to access multiple service providers in the one location for people experiencing street present homelessness in the Fremantle area.

Assistance with getting people housing ready: preparing paperwork, ID, housing assessments and applications, housing options, advocacy and referrals. Support may be provided with establishing a tenancy including sourcing essential home and housekeeping items. Assistance with immediate concerns around health, food and amenities.
